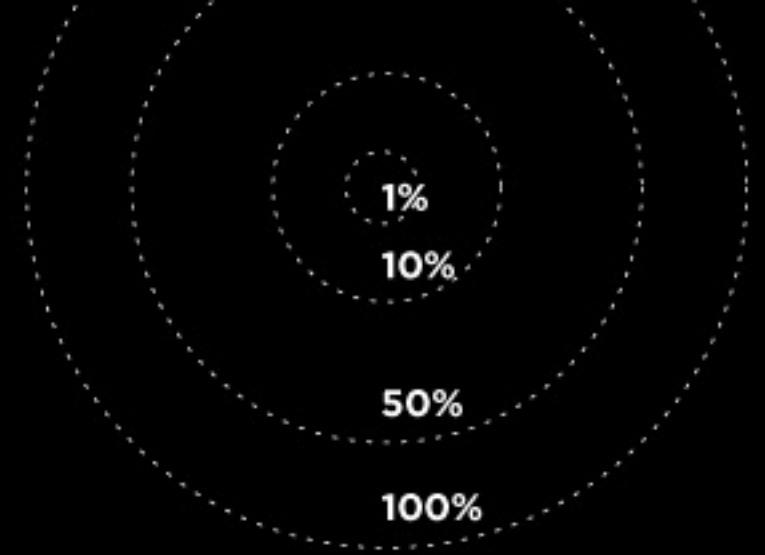


WHAT DRUGS ARE TEENS USING THE MOST?

KEY

Each circle below represents the percentage of each grade level that has done the drug at least one time in the past year (except cigarettes and smokeless tobacco, which are measured for use in the past month as this is the frequency of use that becomes habit-forming). The circles to the right give benchmarks for 100%, 50%, 10%, and 1%.

● 8TH GRADE ● 10TH GRADE ● 12TH GRADE



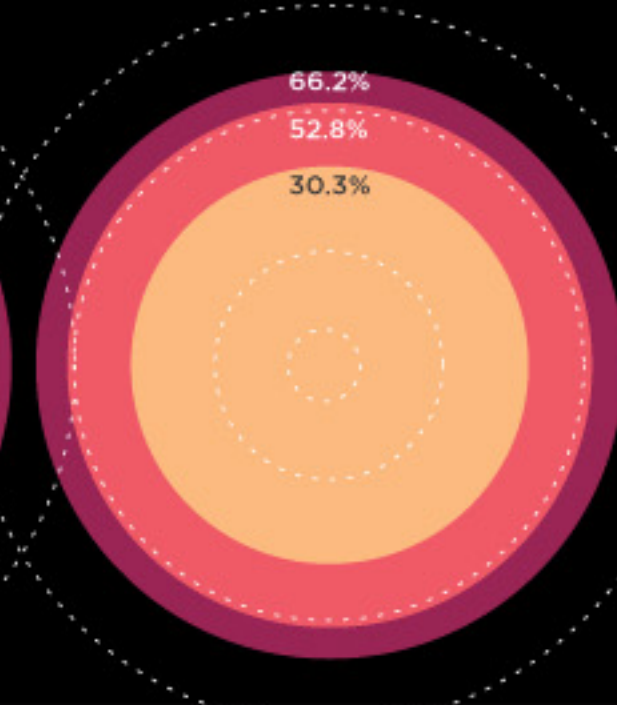
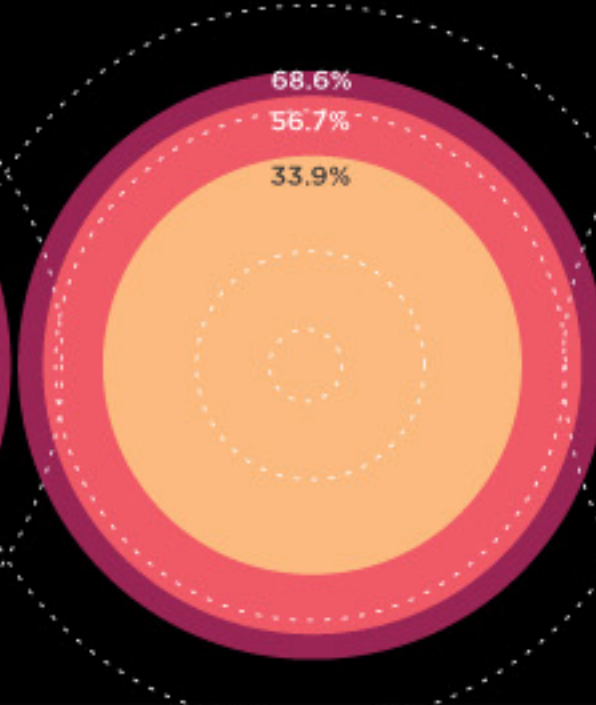
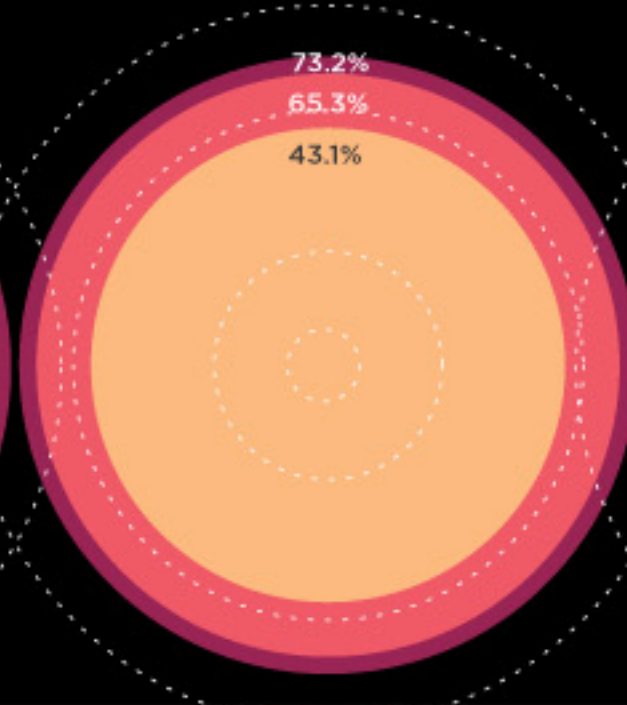
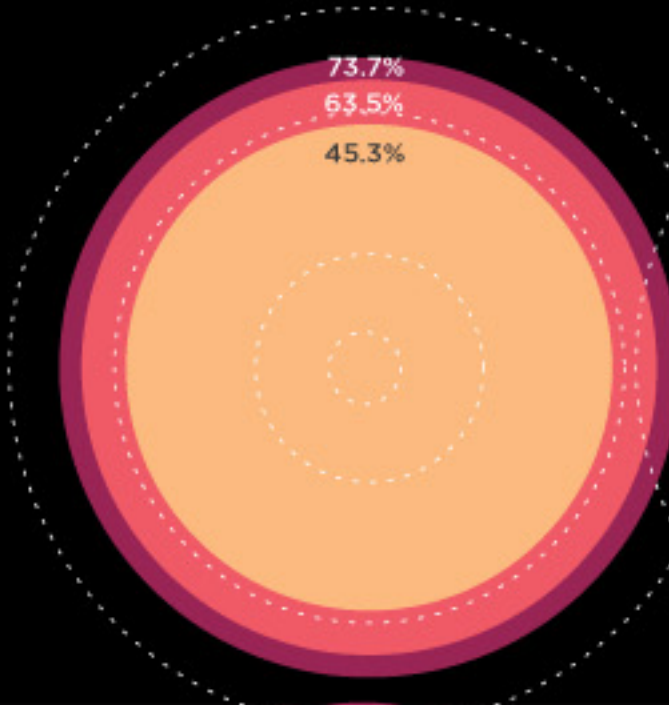

big H, blacktar, smack, brown sugar, dope, mud



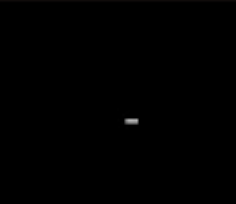
TRANQUILIZERS

juice, roids



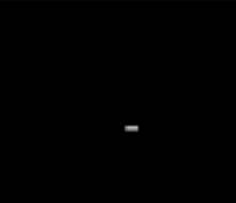

Adam, Ecstasy, E, Kleenex, love drug, Molly, X



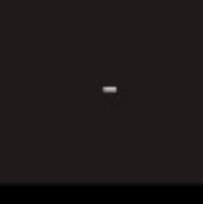
METHAMPHETAMINE
